| <p>Practice CORE reading skills by looking at: articles, blogs or web pages. Responding giving a short answer (single word or phrase). Followed by comprehension skills. Finally note-taking and summary skills. Students will then move on to using reading as a stimuli for their own writing, considering the audience and purpose in what they are saying.</p> <p>Practice CORE listening skills using past papers and resources provided by the exam board. Students will be able to return with short and extended answers and will have the ability to respond to formal and more informal discussion.</p> | <p>Students will prepare for the EXTENDED element of the exam. Continuing revision of comprehension, and summary skills with additional work on vocabulary choices and the reading of complex texts.</p> <p>They will revisit the listening skills at the EXTEND level to assess their suitability for this paper.</p> <p>Furthermore, students will work on their speaking skills. 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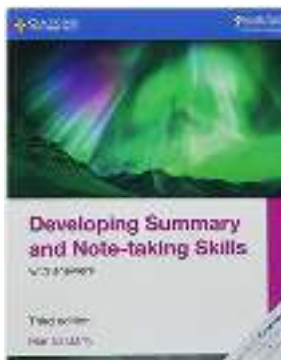
